The Position Papers

The position papers will be used to frame topics to be discussed in a workshop format at the conference. The Conference Organizing Committee is expecting Position Papers with documentation and argumentation on specific challenges in architectural education, internship and practice. These can include speculative visions of the future, changing modes in professional practice or education, the needs of students and interns, or regulatory issues. The papers should also focus on changes in practice and the profession and/or speculate on their future. Specific recommendations for changes to the CACB Conditions and Procedures are also welcome.

Please note that:

- The submission of a position paper topic would not necessarily mean that a proposed topic would become the focus of a workshop session.
- Prior to the conference, the position papers will be summarized for distribution to the conference delegates.
- Position papers will not be presented at the conference.
- The submittal of a position paper does not imply an invitation to the conference in September 2014.
- Any submitted position papers are for the use of the Conference Organizing Committee and may be distributed to the delegates.

Format of the Submissions

The Organizing Committee requests that these position papers be as concise

and precise as possible but are not limited in length. Authors are encouraged to present a position statement, discuss the context, support analysis and arguments with facts and background information, and then provide conclusions and recommendations for improvement.
