
Accreditation **Documents**

CACB Conditions and Terms for Accreditation and

CACB Procedures for Accreditation These are the guiding documents for the accreditation of Programs offering professional degrees in architecture. They outline the requirements that the accredited Programs must meet and the procedures to follow to ensure a uniform, fair, and equitable accreditation process that will uphold the minimum standards in architectural accreditation.

The CACB Conditions and Terms for Accreditation and the CACB Procedures for Accreditation are






Initial

Accreditation

The initial accreditation process has 3 phases: eligibility, candidacy, and accreditation. Institutions intending to establish a professional degree program are encouraged to seek auidance from educational and professional consultants, advisory aroups, and the CCUSA.



Accreditation

Accreditation is reviewed on a regular cycle determined by the previous term of Accreditation The process is undertaken by three parties: the Program, represented by the Program Head; the Visiting Team, represented by the Team Chair; and the CACB Board, represented by the Executive Director. Each of these parties has duties and responsibilities in each phase of the process.
